Pitangatuba (Star Cherry) <i>Eugenia selloi</i>	3g	\$50.00	Very rare fruit. Similar to surinam cherry, but larger and tastier. The bright yellow fruits have a delicious acidic sour/sweet flavor.
Surinam Cherry - Zill Black (Grafted)	3g	\$35.00	Selected variety of surinam cherry with superior flavor and sweetness. Grows extremely well in south Florida.
Jaboticaba	7g	\$80.00	Very unique fruit from brazil, looks like a grape and grows directly on the trunk of the tree. "Sabara" variety
White Sapote var. "Redlands"	7g	\$85.00	White sapote is a delicacy of a fruit, distantly related to citrus, the fruit tastes like vanilla pudding with a hint of tropical essence. Cold hardy, fruit is produced in summer

Bay Rum (Pimenta racemosa)	7g	\$75.00	Very fragrant leaves, similar to allspice. Can be used in cooking.
Pineapple - Elite Gold Sugarloaf White Jade	1g	\$12.00	Easy to grow tropical fruit, can produce fruit in a container. Very low water requirement

Galangal <i>Alpinia</i> spp.	2g	\$45.00	Cousin to ginger, different flavor. Used in Tom Kha soup among other dishes. Much more sun tolerant and is evergreen.
Sugar Cane	2g	\$40.00	Cuban black variety, grows well in full sun, many uses including chewing or pressed for a fantastic juice.
Cassava (Yuca)	1g	\$6.00	Super easy, calorie dense root crop. Plant in full sun and dig after 8 months. Low maintenance <i>Grow your own yuca con mojo!</i>
Cuban Oregano (green, variegated white/green)	4"	\$3, 2 for \$5	Fragrant herb with succulent leaves. Can be used like Italian oregano. Part shade, works well as a houseplant.

Waterleaf (Surinam Purslane)	1g	\$8.00	Latin name <i>Talinum fruticosum</i> , this plant is a great leafy vegetable. Good source of omega-3s, high in vitamins and minerals.
Brazilian Spinach (<i>Alternanthera sissoc</i>)	4"	\$3, 2 for \$5	Attractive low shrub with edible leaves. Can be cooked or eaten raw. Heat tolerant.

Malabar Spinach (<i>Basella alba</i>)	4"	\$3, 2 for \$5	Very productive leafy green for south Florida summers. Heat tolerant, with succulent leaves reminiscent of okra.

Katuk "Sweet Leaf"	1g	\$8.00	A perennial leafy green from the rainforest, loves shade and water. Leaves have a distinct pea flavor and high protein content.

Cranberry Hibiscus (<i>Hibiscus acetosella</i>)	1g	\$8.00	Tart leaves have a zingy flavor, great added to salads. A nice contrast to the landscape. Perennial and will self seed. Red and Pink-flowered varieties

Roselle / Jamaican sorrel (<i>Hibiscus sabdariffa</i>)	1g	\$8.00	Also known as Florida Cranberry - this perennial shrub has edible leaves and produces succulent calyxes after flowering, which can be made into Red Zinger tea or a tropical version of cranberry sauce. This plant used to be a major production crop in south Florida, and is very popular in tropical regions.
Holy Basil / Tulsi	1g	\$8.00	Holy basil is a great medicinal/adaptogenic herb, very popular in India. Makes a nice relaxing tea and the plants attract pollinators when flowering.
Chaya/Tree Spinach (<i>Cnidioscolus acontifolius</i>)	1g	\$6.00	Easy to grow, highly nutritious leafy green (must be cooked). Blooms attract pollinators. Great alternative to collard greens and even easier to grow. Drought tolerant.
Society Garlic	1g	\$8.00	Excellent perennial clumping variety of garlic chives, lots of flavor, light purple blooms.
Aloe Vera	4"	\$3.00	Nutritious and helps with sunburn relief. Grows well in the shade.

Sleeping Hibiscus / Turks cap	1g	\$8.00	Unique variety of hibiscus - flowers only open halfway when blooming, and are edible with a sweet nectar found toward the base.

Firespike	3g	\$20.00	Hardy tropical flowering plant, sends up bright red flower spikes multiple times per year.
Pagoda (<i>Clerodendrum paniculatum</i>)	1g	\$8.00	Beautiful red flowering plant, native to Asia. Very tropical looking, tolerates shade
Blue Porterweed	1g	\$8.00	Native shrub, produces stalks of edible deep blue flowers year round. Attracts pollinators.

Pink Salvia	1g	\$6.00	Tropical sage (<i>Salvia splendens</i>) Native to Brazil. Attracts butterflies
Cuban Buttercup / Damiana (<i>Turnera Ulmifolia</i>)	4"	\$4.00	Native flowering shrub which blooms bright yellow flowers every morning. Leaves can be used for a relaxing tea, also an aphrodisiac. OUT OF STOCK
Milkweed	2g	\$10.00	Host plant for monarch butterflies.
Giant Milkweed	1g	\$6.00	<i>Calotropis gigantea</i> , a host plant for monarch butterflies. Grows 8-10 feet tall with purple flowers
Perennial Peanut	4g	\$6.75	Beautiful nitrogen fixing ground cover, yellow flowers are edible. Great alternative to grass. OUT OF STOCK
Sunshine Mimosa	4g	\$6.75	Fast growing, nitrogen fixing grass alternative. Makes pink "pom pom" flowers in the morning
Fakahatchee Grass	4g	\$8.00	Native grasses are a great addition to an edible landscape. Attracts beneficial wildlife, can be used as chop n drop.
Comfrey (Bocking 14)	2g	\$40.00	Dynamic nutrient accumulator, used for mulch or compost tea. Part shade. Bocking 14 variety.
Blue Butterfly Pea (<i>Clitorea ternatea</i>)	4"	\$4.00	Fast growing vine with loads of edible blue flowers. Perennial. BACK IN STOCK
Toilet Paper plant (Blue Spur Flower)	1g	\$8.00	The name says it all - grow your own TP! This Cuban oregano relative has velvety soft leaves and a pleasant fragrance. Toilet paper for the apocalypse.
